**Notes:**

- Rank 1 is either the highest or the best among provinces.
- Provincial data does not include cities except for land area, population, HDI, tourist arrivals motor vehicles registered, poverty, prices, and education performance indicators.
- Data for the Province of Leyte does not include Tacloban City, being a highly urbanized city. This refers specifically to land area, number of municipalities/barangays, population, revenue collection, IRA, value of exports/imports, tourist arrivals, number of operational ports and airports, motor vehicles registered, literacy rate, education performance indicators, number of schools and hospitals, prevalence of underweight children, and crime incidence.
- Data for Total Revenue Collection for the Province of Leyte includes Biliran.
- LGU income classification is still based on Department Order No. 23-08 dated July 29, 2008 of the Bureau of Local Government Finance.
- In the absence of 2017 provincial population projections, the 2015 total population counts were used in the computation of crime rates.
- Figures may not add up to totals due to rounding.
