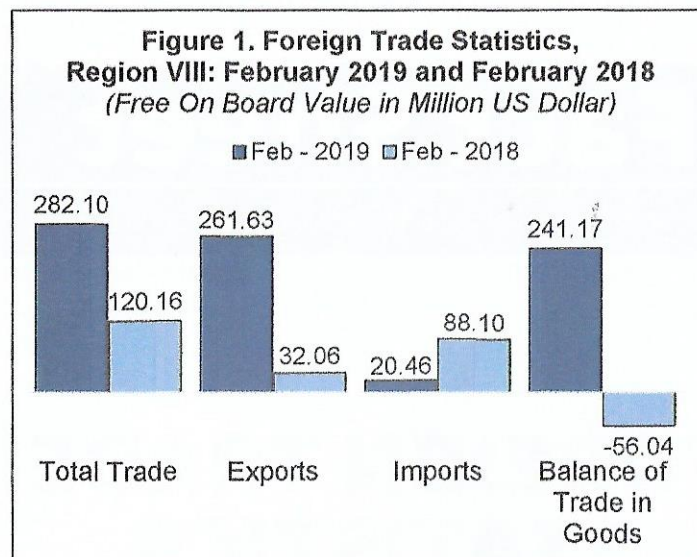

EV posts \$241.17 million trade surplus in February 2019

The region posted a \$241.17 million surplus in the total Balance of Trade in Goods (BoT-G) in February 2019, in contrast to the \$56.04 million deficit in the same period in 2018.

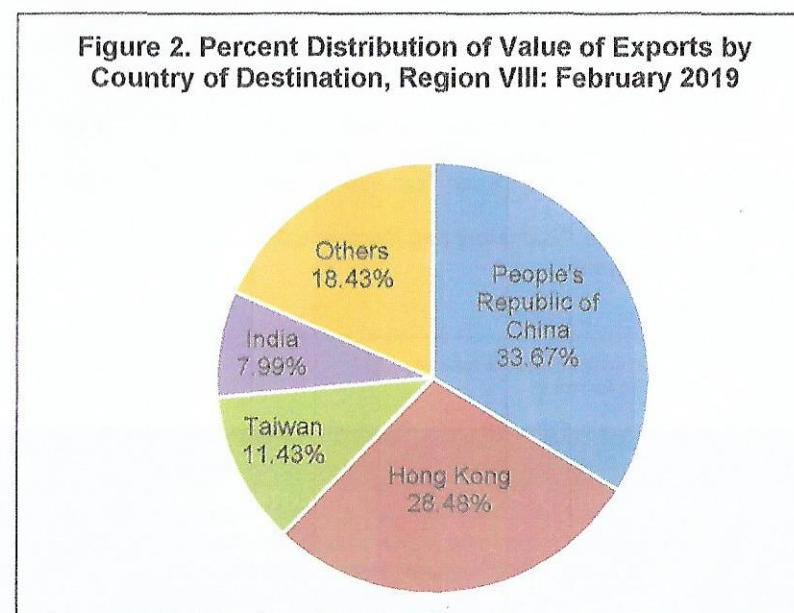
The region's total trade in goods in February 2019 surged to \$282.10 million from \$120.16 million in the same period in 2018, an increase of 134.77 percent

Total value of exports amounted to \$261.63 million, seven times (716.06 percent) higher compared with the \$32.06 million in February 2018. Total value of imports, meanwhile, was recorded at \$20.46 million, significantly lower by 76.78 percent compared with the \$88.10 million imports posted in the same period in 2018.

The region's total volume of exports in February 2019 was posted at 109.10 million kilograms valued at \$261.63 million. The

commodity group of copper and articles thereof was the major export during the month in review with total revenue of \$156.52 million. This accounted for 59.82 percent of the region's total export revenue in February 2019. People's Republic of China was the top export market destination with \$88.10 million total export revenue, which shared 33.67 percent of the region's total exports.

The region's total imports amounted to \$20.46 million in February 2019 with total gross weight of 74.82 million kilograms. Inorganic chemicals; organic or inorganic compounds of precious metals, of rare-earth, of radio-active elements or of isotopes commodity group was the major import during the month with total revenue of \$9.64 million, comprising 47.13 percent of the region's total imports in February 2019. The top import supplier of the region was Vietnam with total import bill of \$5.91 million, this shared 28.87 percent of the region's total imports.
