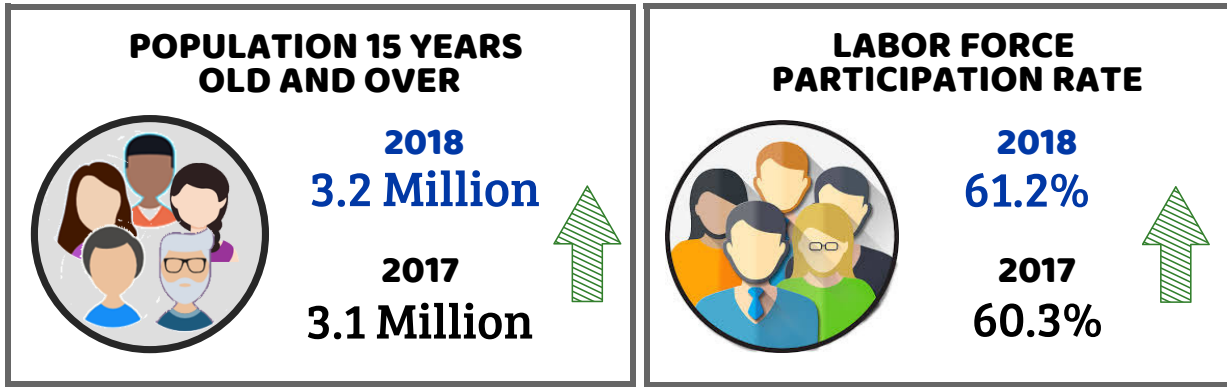

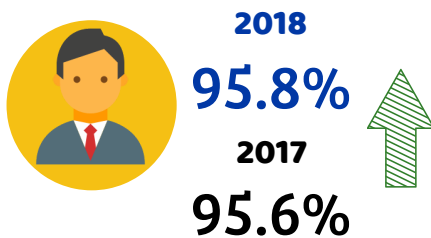

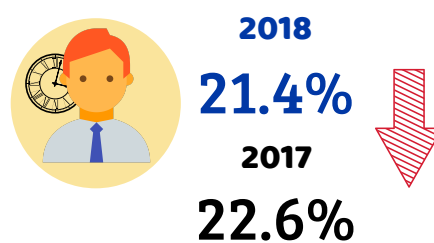
EMPLOYMENT STATUS



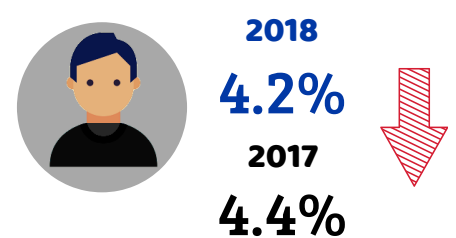
EMPLOYED

UNEMPLOYED



EMPLOYED - persons in the labor force who are reported as either at work (at least one hour), or with a job or business although not at work.

UNDEREMPLOYED - employed persons who express the desire to have additional hours of work in their present job or an additional job, or have a new job with longer working hours.

UNEMPLOYED - persons in the labor force who are reported as without work; and currently available for work and seeking work or not seeking work due to the following reasons: a) belief that no work is available, or b) awaiting results of previous job application, or c) because of temporary illness or disability, or d) bad weather, or e) waiting for rehire or job recall.

Notes: The methodology for the computation of annual estimates of labor and employment indicators is based on PSA Board Resolution No. 01, Series of 2017-151, Approving and Adopting the Official Methodology for Generating Annual Labor and Employment Estimates, using the average estimates of the four LFS rounds.

The annual estimates were based on the final results of the 2017 LFS, and January and April rounds of 2018 LFS and preliminary results of the July and October rounds of 2018 LFS.
