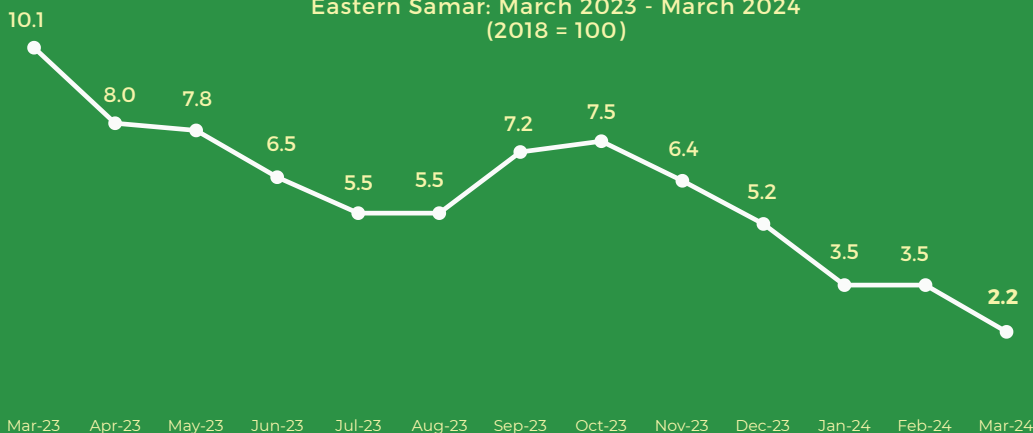

Technical Notes

Inflation Rate (IR) - is defined as the annual rate of change or the year-to-year change in the CPI.

Consumer Price Index (CPI) - is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Purchasing Power of the Peso (PPP) - is a measure of the real value of the peso in a given period relative to a chosen reference period.
