28 November 2024 MAASIN SOUTHERN LEYTE. The Provincial Product Accounts (PPA) Dissemination Forum was successfully conducted by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) - Southern Leyte Provincial Statistical Office on November 28, 2024 at Pering Chaibio Building I, Tunga-tunga, Maasin City. PPA is a mechanism that aims to present a comprehensive picture of the provincial and Highly Urbanized City (HUC) economies. Through the PPA, the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) or the economic performance of the provinces and highly

urbanized cities are estimated, which will serve as an important tool in economic planning and policy formulation at the subregional levels to supplement the GDP at the national and regional levels or the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP).
