#### **\$25.80M** Trade Surplus in January 2025 Eastern Visayas posts

The balance of trade in goods (BoT-G) in January 2025 was recorded at USD 25.80 million, indicating a trade surplus which increased by 144.7 percent from USD 57.71 million trade deficit in January 2024.
