Technical Notes:

Aging index is calculated as the number of persons 60 years old and over per one hundred persons under the age of 15 years. Median age is the age that divides the population into two numerically equal groups; that is, half of the population are younger than this age and the other half are older. Household is a social unit consisting of person or a group of persons who sleep in the same housing unit and have a common arrangement in the preparation and consumption of food. Household population refers to all persons who are members of the household. Overall dependency ratio is the number of persons under 15 years old (young dependents) and persons aged 65 and older (old dependents) per one hundred persons 15 to 64 years old (working-age or eco-nomically-productive group) in a population. Population pyramid is a bar chart, arranged vertically, that shows the distribution of a population by age and sex. By convention, the younger ages are at the bottom, with males on the left and females on the right

right. **Sex ratio** is the number of males per one hundred females in a population.
