- 3. Data for the Province of Leyte does not include Tacloban City, being a highly urbanized city. This refers specifically to land area, number of barangays, population, IRA, value of exports/imports, tourist arrivals, number of operational ports and airports, motor vehicles registered, poverty indicators, prices, literacy rate, education performance indicators, labor and employment statistics, number of schools and hospitals, prevalence of underweight children, and crime incidence.
- 4. Data for Total Revenue Collection for the Province of Leyte includes Biliran.
- 5. LGU income classification is still based on Department Order No. 23-08 dated July 29, 2008 of the Bureau of Local Government Finance.
- 6. Quarterly crime rates were computed using the updated projected 2024 mid-year population based on the 2015 Census of Population results. Crime incidents were generated from PNP PRO 8 as of 03 July 2024.
- 7. Newly registered motor vehicles at the LTO Regional Office are counted in Leyte, instead in Tacloban City, since their transfer of office to Palo, Leyte in July 2020.
- 8. Number of Ports include port projects of the Department of Transportation and Local Government Units.
- 9. Hog and Chicken inventory starting 2022 are based on the new design of Backyard Livestock and Poultry Survey and new survey frame for Commercial Livestock and Poultry Survey.
- 10. Figures may not add up to totals due to rounding.
