The Province of Eastern Samar is the Fastest Growing Among Provincial Economies in the Eastern Visayas Region with 8.1 Percent Growth in 2023



The economy of the Province of Eastern Samar grew by 8.1 percent in 2023 from its 2022 level, the fastest among all provinces in the Eastern Visayas Region during the period. The main contributors to the 2023 growth of the province were: Transportation and storage, 47.7 percent; Construction, 7.9 percent; and Mining and quarrying, 120.5 percent. (Figure 1)



Among the 16 industries, the fastest growths were observed in Mining and quarrying with 120.5 percent, followed by Transportation and storage with 47.7 percent, and Other services with 25.3 percent. On the other hand, Agriculture, forestry, and fishing experienced negative growth rate, declining by 1.9 percent.

Of the six provinces and one Highly Urbanized City of Eastern Visayas Region, the Province of Eastern Samar registered the highest growth rate in 2023, followed by Southern Leyte and the City of Tacloban. These three provinces posted GDP growths higher than the regional GDP growth rate of 6.4 percent. (Figure 2)
